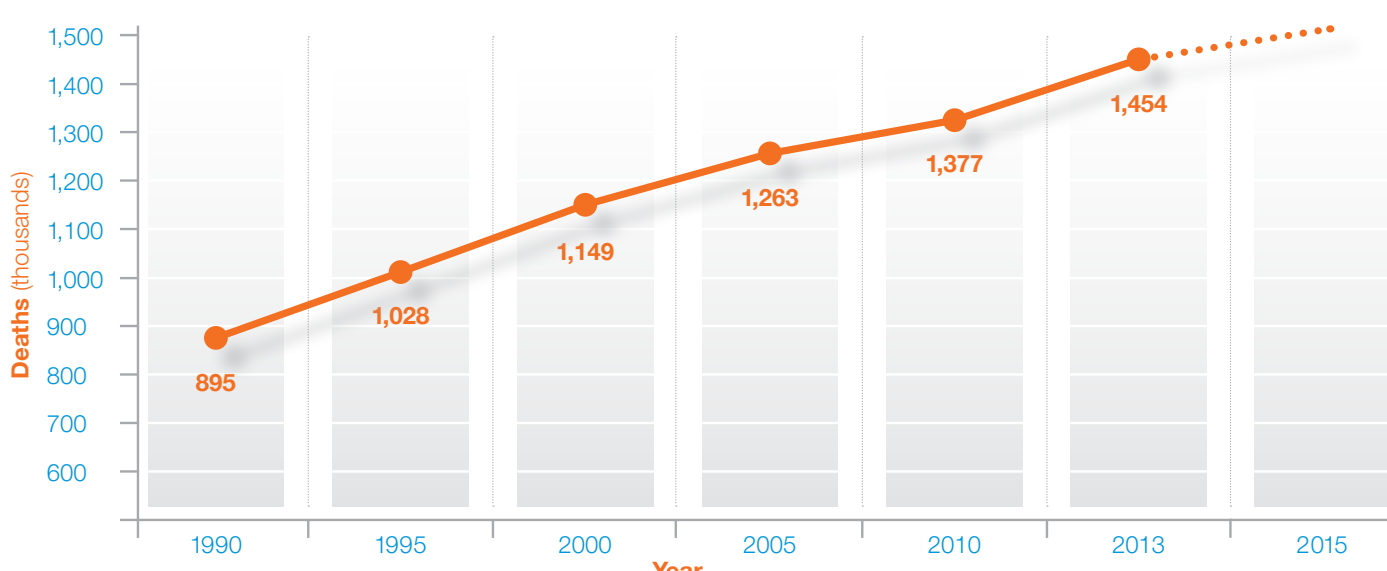

Viral hepatitis kills more than 1.4 million people a year, yet there is a remarkable lack of global awareness and action to combat the disease.



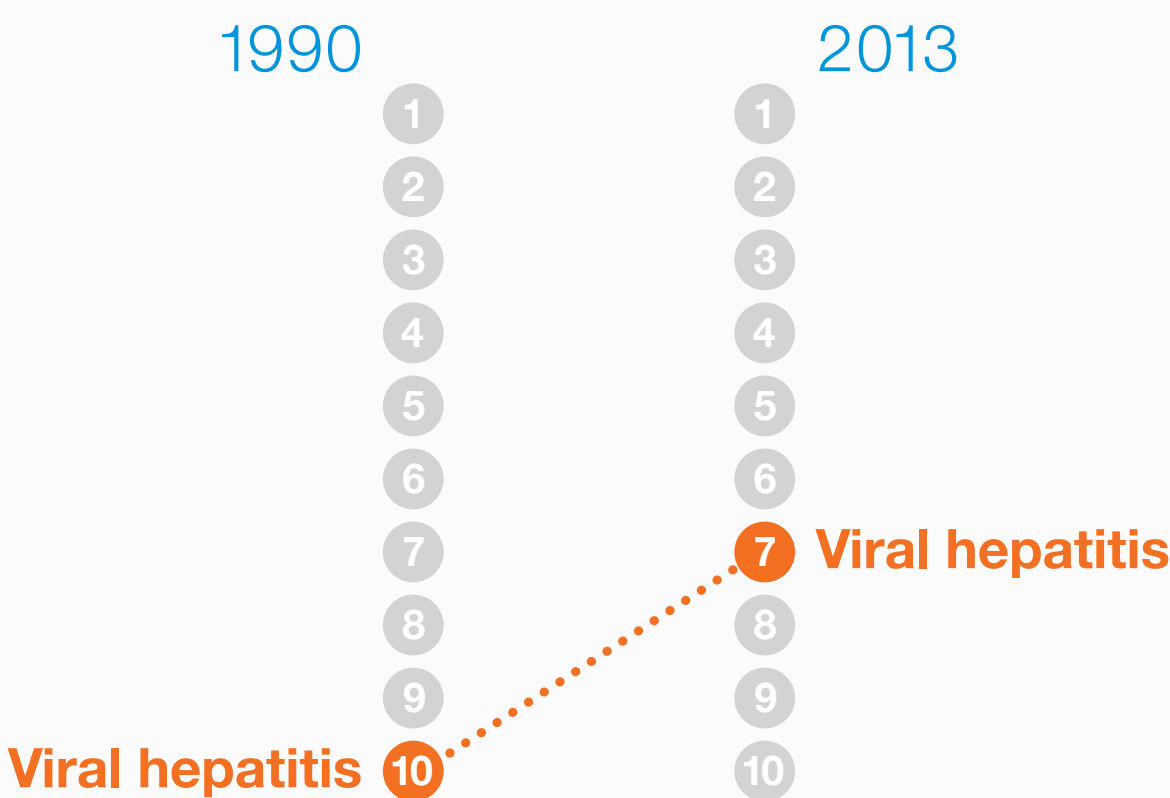
Challenges
